Industry confidence in the Southeast falls, impacting national results

In April 2025, the confidence of the industry in the Southeast region of Brazil fell to the lowest level since June 2020, with a significant impact on the national result of industry confidence. In addition to the Southeast region, industry confidence also fell in the Northeast, North, and Central-West, among all company sizes (small, medium, and large) and among 15 of 29 sectors.

With the month's results, large industries and five industrial sectors made a transition from confidence to lack of confidence between March and April. Thus, all industrial company sizes (small, medium, and large), industries in the Southeast and South regions, as well as 23 of 29 sectors of the industry, register a lack of confidence in April 2025.



ICEI by Industry Sectors

In April 2025, industry confidence fell in 15 of 29 sectors, increased in 13 sectors, and did not vary in one sector. As a result, five sectors of the industry migrated from confidence to lack of confidence and three industrial sectors made the opposite transition, from lack of confidence to confidence.

Thus, the balance for the month of April is a lack of confidence in 23 of 29 industrial sectors and confidence in only six sectors.

ICEI by company size

In April 2025, the confidence of the industry in the Southeast region of Brazil fell 1.3 points - the largest drop among all regions - to 45.9 points. It is the lowest level of confidence in the Southeast industry since June 2020, with a significant impact on the national ICEI result, which also showed its worst result since 2020.

Confidence also fell in the North (-1.1 points), Central-West (-0.8 points), and Northeast (-0.6 points) regions. In the South, industry confidence remained practically stable (+0.2 points).

Industries in the Southeast and South regions continue to lack confidence. On the other hand, industries in the other regions remain confident, despite the drop in confidence in April. With the drop, the index of the Central-West region is practically on the dividing line that separates confidence from lack of confidence, at 50.2 points.
